CAT 207 : Practicum I: Creative Arts in Therapy with the Individual

This course combines classroom learning with practicum experience in the community. The first half of the course is devoted to the development of individual interviewing techniques and treatment planning. Assessment of needs, establishment of treatment goals and objectives and the development of appropriate creative arts therapy methodology for one population are the focus.
